GENERAL INFORMATION FOR 2019 SUMMER STUDY GRANTS

NOTE: Only students entering High School in the fall, students already in High School, with the exception of past/current grant recipients, will be eligible to receive grants.

1. The scholarship recipient shall be chosen on the basis of merit, musical ability, character and need following an audition before the scholarship committee.
2. The summer music study program may be the student's choice.
3. Payment of the scholarship shall be only to the music school or private teacher.
4. The Scholarship Committee's decision, based on the judges' input, and other considerations, will be final.
5. The scholarship awards are funded annually by the Music Club of Hollywood Florida. The number and dollar value of the awards will vary from year to year.
6. Scholarship Applicant must be an American citizen.
and must be a current resident of Broward or Dade County, Florida.
8. Late or incomplete applications are grounds for disqualification.
9. Awarded students are encouraged to schedule a performance at a regularly scheduled Music Club meetings or special events during the upcoming November – May season.
10. The Music Club of Hollywood Florida reserves the right to use audio and video recordings made under our sponsorship for promotional purposes. We will ask the student permission for use of media that is made public on Youtube and other video sharing sites that is searchable on the internet.
11. The Music Club of Hollywood will not issue checks related to Summer Study Grants after September 15, 2019.

AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

1. A Scholarship Application must be completed in full and postmarked by **March 1, 2019**
2. The applicant should prepare a program of no less than five and no more than ten minutes.
3. Works should be carefully chosen to display the student's best abilities and highest standards of performance. The number of selections chosen will be determined by the five to ten minute rule allowed for each student.
4. The applicant must send a copy of his program with names of composers and approximate performance time of each composition on his/her program to the Scholarship Chairman postmarked or emailed fourteen days prior to the date of the audition.
5. The Music Club will provide a piano accompanist at no charge. Music must be received for the accompanist (by the Scholarship Chairman) by March 15, either by mail or email. Students may also choose their own accompanist if they so desire.
6. All applicants should arrive thirty minutes before the audition start. Late arrival is grounds for potential disqualification. Applicants are expected to stay for all performances.
7. We will provide an accompanist at no charge. **If the applicant elects to use our accompanist he/she must notify us and provide a copy of the piano part no later than March 15, 2018. Those who do not need our accompanist must send selection titles by March 22, 2019.** Rehearsals with the pianist will take place starting at 8:00 AM on the day of the audition, in the order

of arrival. 8. One published copy and two legible photocopies of each selection to be performed by the applicant are to be given to the Scholarship Chairman before the audition. The music will be used by the judges and returned to the applicant after the audition.

AUDIO OR VIDEO SUBMISSION REQUIRED

The applicant is expected to submit an audio or video sample of their work of about 10 minutes duration. It can be a CD, DVD, MP3, or VIDEO FILE. Please include it with the application.
